NOTICE OF RACE

1. **Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, as modified by Appendix E regarding radio sailing, the Sailing Instructions and the DF65 & DF95 Class Rules.
2. **Eligibility:** The regatta is open to entrants sailing boats of the DF65 or DF95 Class whose skippers are current members of the AMYA or other national authority.
3. **Scoring :**
 - 3.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A will be used, with the following races excluded from a boat's score – 1 exclusion after 4 races, 2 exclusions after 8 races, 3 exclusions after 16 races, 4 exclusions after 24 races, one additional exclusion for each additional races.
 - 3.2 Depending on the final number of boats scheduled to race on race day, the race committee will decide whether to use a heat management system and what heat management system will be used. That decision will be announced prior to all racing at the skipper's meeting.
4. **Registration fee:** \$25 per class
5. **Entry:** Regatta will be limited to 30 boats each day. Entries will be assigned in the order the entry forms are received. Entry can be done on line or eligible boats may be entered by completing the attached Entry Form and submitting it prior to August 31, 2022 with an entry fee of \$25 per class, guest lunches \$9 per day. Entry fee and guest lunch fee includes: coffee and doughnuts, drinks and lunch on Saturday and Sunday. (Does not include dinner on Friday or Saturday.)
